ORDER :

The Secretary, State Employment Market Information Officer and Secretary, Andhra Pradesh Soldiers', Sailors' & Airmen's Board, in the reference Ist cited has requested Government for early issue of orders on the resolution adopted at the Fifth Meeting of the Andhra Pradesh State Soldiers', Sailors' & Airmen's Board, Hyderabad held on 15-12-1965 for giving priority in the treatment of ex-servicemen and Non-Gazetted Officers.

The Director of Medical Services who was consulted in the matter has stated that in case the ex-servicemen T.B. Patients have to take their chance of admission next to State Government servants it may not be possible for them to get admission in as much as the Government Servant will always be on the waiting list. He has, therefore, recommended that the suggestion to give priority, according to the registration seniority among the ex-servicemen and Non-Gazetted Officers, may be agreed to.

The Government, after careful examination of the recommendation of the Director of Medical Services, direct that priority should be given to the ex-servicemen T.B. Patients for admission into the Governmnet T.B. Medical Institutions according to Registration seniority among ex-servicemen and the Non-Gazetted Officers.
