ANDHRA PRADESH STATE SOLDIER'S 'SAILOR'S' AND AIRMEN'S BOARD –
Appointment of a whole-time officer as Secretary –Creation of a Gazette Post – Orders – Issued.

ORDER:

The Ministry of Defense , Government of India , in its letter first cited , have forwarded an extract of item IX of the minutes of Indain Soldier's Sailor's and Airmen's Board held in December 1963 with a request to implement the recommendations contained therein in respect of the following:-

1. Appointment of a whole-time officer as the Secretay of State Soldier's 'Sailor's ' and Airmen's Board.
2. The recommendations of the Board are that the appointment of whole-time officer as Secretary , State Soldier's Sailor's and Airmen's Board should be accepted as the basic requirement.The matter was further discussed in the meeting of the Indian Soldier's and Airmen's Board , New Delhi , in April 1964 and January 1965. While communicating the views about the necessity and choice of the officer expressed by the members of the Indians Soldier's, Sailor's, and Airmen's Board , the government of India considered that the officer who is posted as Secretary , State Soldier's Sailor's and Airmen's Board Should be a fairly Senior officer who has served about 10 to 12 years as a Gazetted Officer so that he may be in a position to carry weight with the other Departments of the State Government and assistance from businessmen who can employ a good number of

ex-servicemen in their concerns .He should also hold whole-time charge of the appoint.He should be specially selected on the basis of his aptitude and interest shown in the welfare of ex-servicemen while working in the districts.

3. The Director of Employment and Training when consulted also stated that the work of the state Soldier's Sailor's and Airmen's Board warrants a whole-time Secretary as the duties attached to the post are responsible and innumerable.
4. The government after careful examination of the whole question in the light of the recommendations made by Indian Soldier's Sailor's and Airmen's Board ,New Delhi and the partice obtaining in the neighbouring States , hereby Sanction the creation of a Gazetted Post in the pay scale of Rs.600-50/1-1,000.
5. The post will be for one year in the instance.
6. The Director of Employment and Training is requested to submit proposals for the appointment of a suitable officer Keeping in view the recommendations made by the Indian Soldier's Sailor's and Airmen's Board , New Delhi in this respect.
7. The Director of Employment and Training , Hyderabad , is also requested to submit adhoc rules to govern the above post.
8. The expenditure involed in the above proposal may be met from the head of account "71.Misc – g – Misc , & Unforeseen Charges –H – Andhra Pradesh State Soldier's Sailor's and Airmen's Board etc. " by providing additional allotment by way of supplementary grant.
9. This Order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department – Vide their U.O.No.2+6047/Expr./66-1, dated 9-4-1966.
